There are multiple ways to prepare for the **Career Technical Education Teaching Credential** including completing coursework at Cuesta and work experience directly related to each industry sector.

WANT TO TEACH? HERE'S HOW:

STEP 1 Be a current student at Cuesta College, or apply online at: cuesta.edu/admissionsaid/apply

STEP 2 Choose from the following:

- Complete 48 units at Cuesta College and 1,000 hours work experience in CTE industry sector
- Complete 24 units at Cuesta College and 2,000 hours work experience in CTE industry sector
- Complete 3,000 hours of work experience in CTE industry sector

STEP 3 Apply for your preliminary CTE teaching credential
