WANT TO TEACH? HERE'S HOW:

OPTION 1

STEP 1 Be a current student at Cuesta College, or apply online at: cuesta.edu/admissionsaid/apply

STEP 2 Earn Cuesta College's Associate Degree in Early Childhood Education (ECE)

STEP 3 Complete the field experience requirements by working in the ECE field to gain experience teaching infants, toddlers and preschoolers

OPTION 2

Be a current student at Cuesta College, or apply online at: cuesta.edu/admissionsaid/apply

STEP 2 Earn Cuesta College's Associate Degree for Transfer in Early Childhood Education (ECE), plus ECE 245 (Adult Supervision) and six ECE specialization units

STEP 3 Transfer to a university to complete a Bachelor's Degree in ECE, Child Development or similar major

STEP 4 Complete the field experience requirements by working in the ECE field to gain experience teaching infants, toddlers and preschoolers
