ENGAGE SCHOLARSHIP & MENTORING PROGRAM

FOR ENGINEERING AND COMPUTER SCIENCE MAJORS

Scholarship funding up to \$7700/year*

Students selected for ENGAGE will be a part of a student cohort who are targeting transfer in Fall 2022. Each ENGAGE Scholar will be mentored by both Cuesta and Cal Poly faculty, participate in training to recognize and develop their internal strengths, have access to coaching, tutoring and other activities to grow personally, academically and professionally.

Requirements

To be eligible, Engineering and Computer Science students must be:

- Pursuing B.S. in Engineering or Computer Science and targeting Cal Poly SLO as a great option
- On track to transfer in Fall 2022
- Current GPA of 2.7 or above** (for students new to Cuesta College, this will be based on your Fall 2020 GPA)
- Must have successfully completed Calculus 1 by the start of Spring 2021
- Able to maintain a GPA of 2.9 or above
- US Citizen, permanent resident, or national refugee
- Eligible to receive need-based financial aid determined by the 2020–2021 FAFSA application
- Plan to enroll full-time at Cuesta College in Spring 2021 and while participating in the ENGAGE Scholarship & Mentoring Program in 2021–22
