

Meeting: April 26, 2019 – IEC/IPPR Themes from CPPRs 2019-2020 and 2018-2019

Themes:

- 1. Few programs have closed the loop and showed evidence of dialog about assessment and actions taken as a result of discussion.
- 2. Statements such as "No Changes" are noted in the prompt response.
- 3. Inconsistency across disciplines about expectations regarding outcomes and assessment.
- 4. Focus on course level outcomes

Recommendations:

- 1. Collect data more frequently suggest a minimum of collection once every two years across all courses.
- Provide Examples of CPPRs from each cluster that have addressed the prompts/questions to faculty to help them identify what the college/committees are expecting from the question

Actions:

- 1. Division Dialog Days
 - a. Dean Medeiros and Susan Kline will be working on prompts to help facilitate division chairs to have dialog across disciplines
- 2. Take Recommendations to Cabinet and move forward as appropriate
- 3. As a resource for departments- **EXAMPLES** of CPPRs from each cluster will be added to the IPPR sharepoint siite for guidance on answering prompts/questions.
