

# INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

APPLICATION TIMELINES	
Attend Cuesta in the	Submit paperwork between
Fall	January 1 to July 1
Spring	October 1 to December 1
Summer	April 1 to May 1

The following documents are required for admission to Cuesta College. Students must maintain full-time enrollment during the entire semester (Fall and Spring term = 12 credits, Summer term = 9 credits)

After your online admission application has been processed, you will receive an email from the Admissions Office with your Cuesta student ID number and username/temporary password to Cuesta's web portal *my*Cuesta. You will register and pay fees online via your *my*Cuesta account, including activating your Cuesta email.

F-1 student must have sufficient financial resources to cover full-time (12 credits) enrollment tuition, housing, personal care, and other educational costs while attending Cuesta College.

# □ Proof of English Proficiency

- 1) Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL iBT) or
- 2) The International English Language Testing System (IELTS)

F-1 students must submit official proof by U.S. mail (no e-mails or faxes) of passing the TOEFL iBT (required score minimums: Internet-based: 61, computer-based: 173, or paper-based: 500), or the IELTS (required minimum overall band score of 6). Exam must be completed within the year. *(Exception: Test scores are waived if your native language is English, or if you have completed the equivalent of college-level English composition at a US college or university.)* 

#### □ Transcripts of International Student Academic Records

Submit certified official transcripts of academic records achieved during all prior high school or college attendance. Records outside of the U.S. must be evaluated by a verified evaluation service, such as <u>SpanTran</u> (reduced cost for Cuesta applicants) or <u>ACEI</u> (Academic Credentials Evaluation Institute, Inc.). Transcripts submitted must bear the school seal and be signed by the registrar or another appropriate official.

Do not submit transcripts by email or fax.

#### □ **Tuberculosis Clearance** (Do not submit X-ray film)

Physician's certificate of negative skin test or a chest X-ray for tuberculosis must be completed within one year.

#### □ Copy of Valid Passport and F1 Visa (if applicable)

Applicants must submit a legible copy of their passport and F1 Visa.

#### □ \$100 International Application Fee

Check or money order in US dollars payable to Cuesta College, or credit card payable in myCuesta student portal.
